



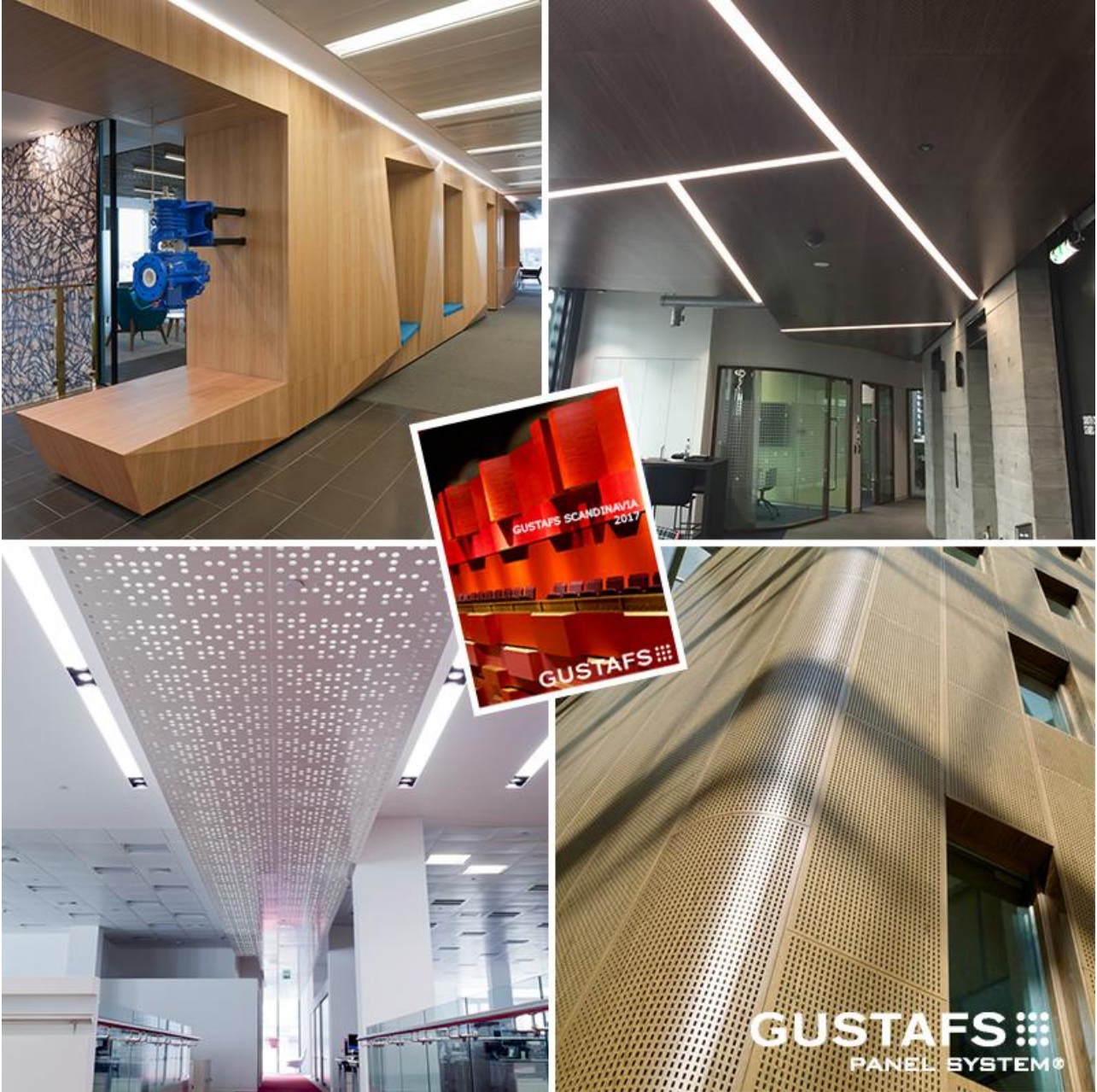

Panels can be perforated in a choice of [40 pre-defined styles](#) (including the invisible nano perforation) to achieve various levels of acoustic control with the option of a completely custom perforation pattern.

Custom finishing is also available from the factory; in addition to a wide range of natural wood veneers, staining, painting and glossing options panels are available with inset or backlighting to compliment perforations and a range of digital design printing as well as full metallic or metallic design application, specialist veneers and finishing materials including laminates and metals.

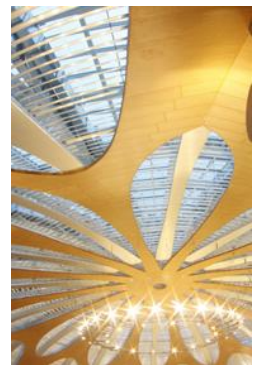
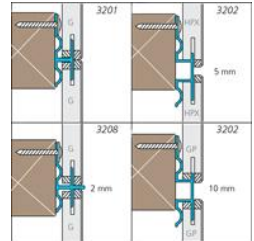
